FAS Prize 2024 for academic research on employee share ownership 6th edition - Call for research

The Scientific Committee of the French Federation of Associations for Employee Share ownership (FAS) will award for the 6th time on November 14th, 2024 the “Prize for academic research on employee share ownership”.

Endowed with 3600 euros in 2024, the prize aims at rewarding annually thorough academic research works (Ph D thesis, books, articles in scientific reviews, study cases) on legal*, economic, social and management aspects of employee shareholder ownership (ESO) in French companies or in companies established in other countries published since 2021. It includes also impact studies on labour relations and companies governance, on workers savings and on CSR, partly or totally used in connection with ESO, as well as comparative works between ESO and other forms of workers participation in the equity of their company. Works carried out in the framework of a French CIFRE contract would also be welcome. We welcome as well French or International candidates.

Concerned persons are invited to send a short description (1 to 2 pages) describing the object of their works to Philippe BERNHEIM, Vice-chairman of FAS Scientific Committee, at the latest on October 15th, 2024. After a preliminary review, selected candidates will be asked to provide a pdf copy of their work and a curriculum vitae mentioning, where applicable, the steps in candidate’s research as well as other published works. The prize will be awarded by the FAS Scientific Committee during its meeting held on November 14th, 2024 and delivered in Paris on December 18th, 2024.
